Acknowledge the Sacred in the interdependent web of life

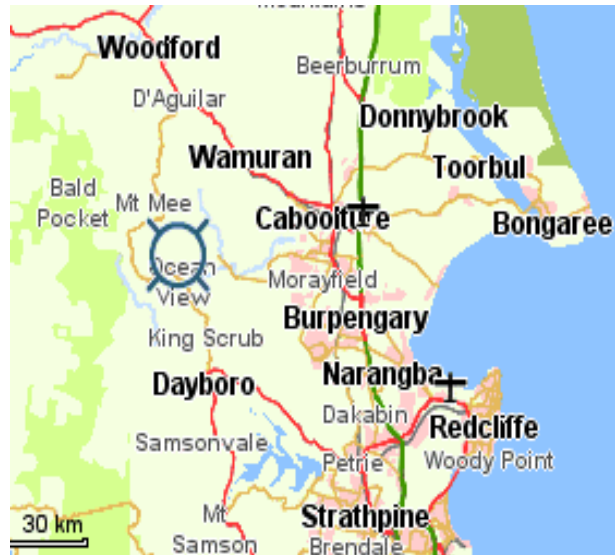
Honour the Sacred in the web of life through rituals and holistic living

*Four Winds* provides a focus for the activities of *Earth Link*. The property is 43 acres of open forest situated on the edges of the D'Aguilar Range, with views eastwards towards Moreton Bay.

- Soak in the views of Moreton Bay and the D'Aguilar Range
- Conduct group activities
- Stay for a day, a week, a month

The facilities include

- Well marked bush-walking tracks
- Space for a limited number of camping sites
